

GLOBAL GOVERNANCE PROGRAMME

This short programme will guide students in exploring the diverse dimensions of **global governance**.

The courses are designed to examine the notion's historical evolution, as well as its key actors and institutions, and the prospects and challenges involved in addressing global issues.

Students will attend **lectures** led by some of the foremost specialists in global governance and international organisations at Sciences Po, providing unique insights into the institutional dynamics involved in tackling global challenges (climate change, economic governance, AI regulation, international migration, etc.). They will also take part in small-group **methodology sessions** organized by level, allowing them to examine contemporary case studies and engage in interactive, in-depth discussions on the lecture themes.

Students can choose to book their accommodation through Sciences Po with our housing partner Fiap, located in central Paris

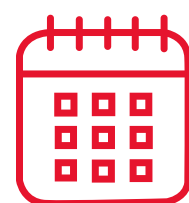
